

Extra Credit: Mapping Holmes' London

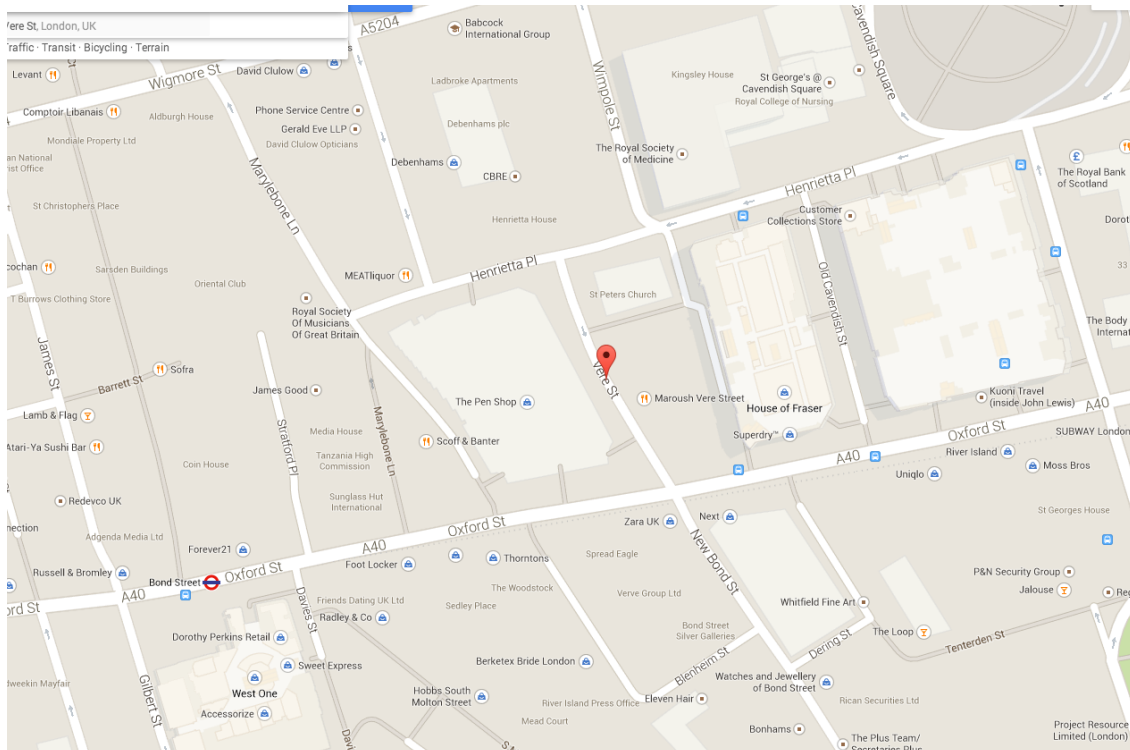
Adds up to six points on your first paper grade (three points per coordinate)

Due: Friday, May 2nd by midnight to SafeAssign

For this assignment, you will need to locate and map locations that appear in the original Holmes stories. This can be any location mentioned in the original canon—addresses, street locations, landmarks, etc. Your job is to find these analogues in modern London.

To do this, you'll need access to GoogleMaps. When you find the location, copy the coordinates/modern address OR take a screenshot of the mapped location and put them into a Word document. Thus, your assignment should look like this:

1. **Vere Street, London.** Location where Holmes is almost killed by a falling brick in "The Final Problem"



Note: If you want to copy and paste coordinates, you'll likely have to use GoogleEarth instead.

You can find up to two locations worth three points each.
